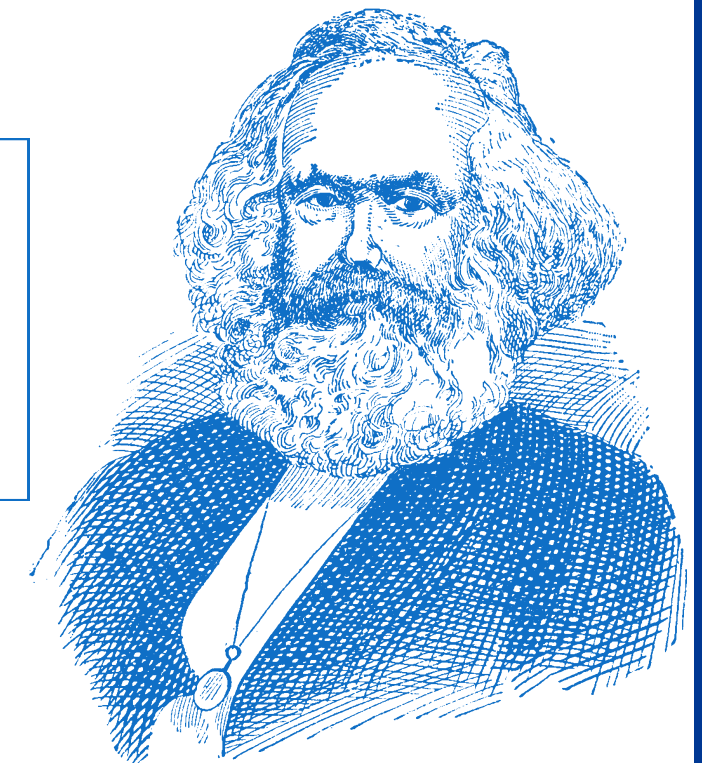
The **Bolsheviks** take control of Petrograd and Moscow, overthrowing the Provisional Government.
