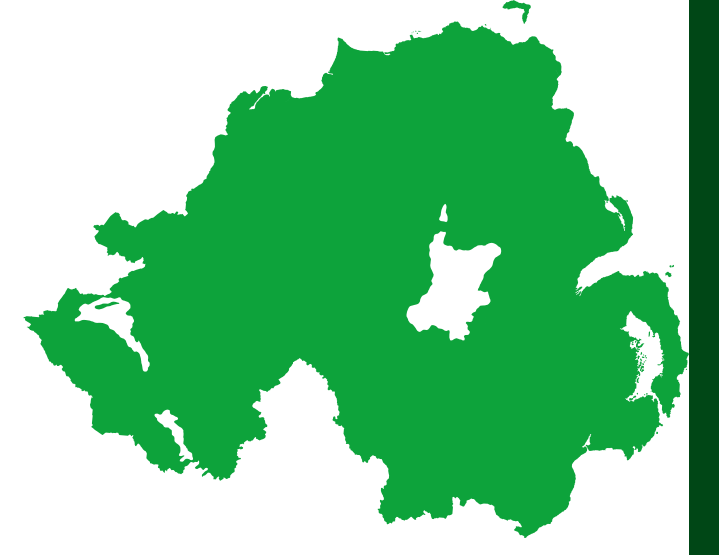
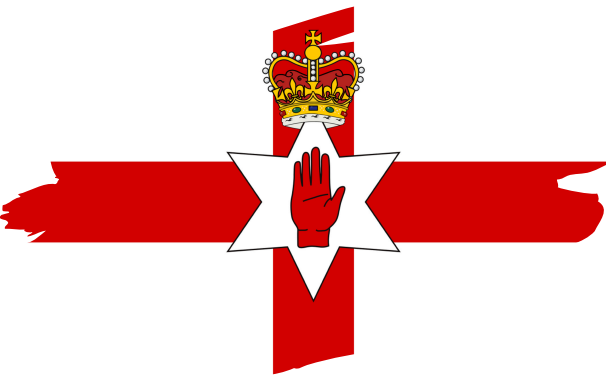

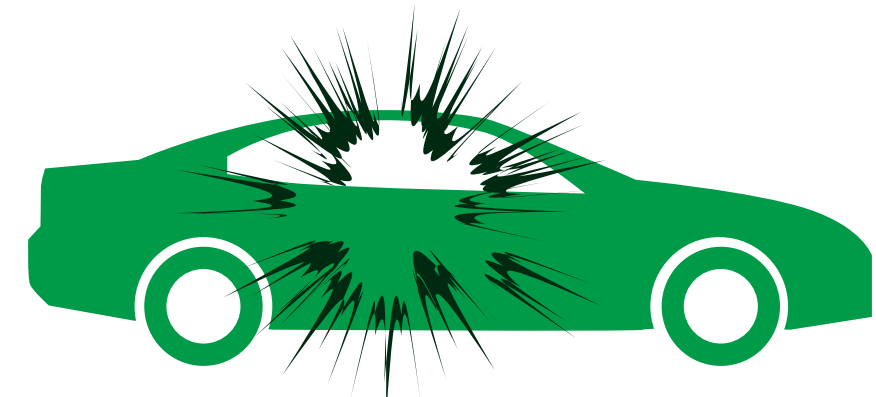
The Troubles in Northern Ireland begin, lasting for almost two decades.

The Provisional IRA announce the end of their armed campaign



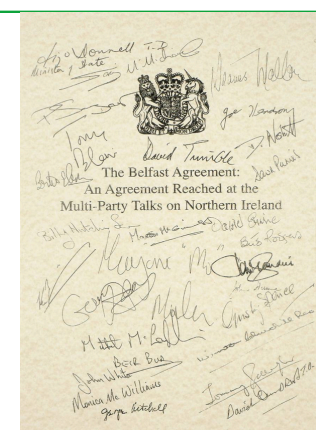
The Ulster Volunteer Force (UVF) was founded
