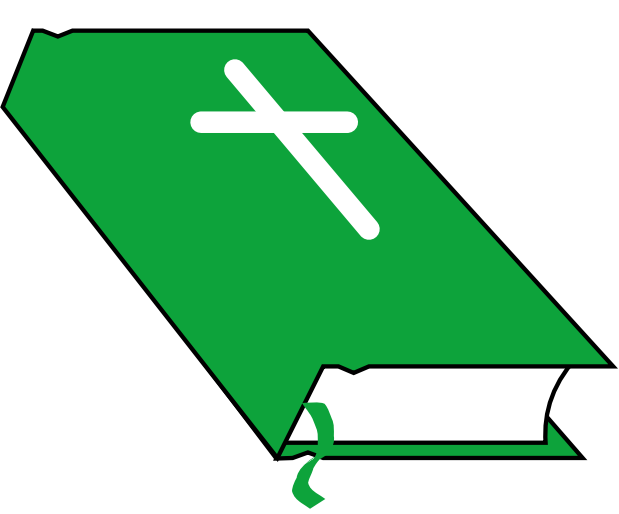


Early Christian Ireland
